



## **DCathlon DC Generator Set Limited Warranty**

### **Basic Coverage**

#### **Coverage Period**

This is a limited warranty that applies to all Cummins Power Products (hereafter referred to as "CPP") brand DCathlon DC Generator Sets and associated Accessory items (hereafter referred to as "Product"). Product will be free from defects in material and workmanship for a period of one year (1) from the date of "in service" or 18 months from shipment to the first end user, whichever comes first. (Permanently installed is defined as Product is installed and intended to remain in place for its lifetime.) Under this policy, Product is only allowed to be placed in storage up to six (6) months after date of shipment in order for the warranty to be intact.

#### **Service & Replacement Parts**

Repair or replacement parts are warranted for ninety (90) days from the day of purchase, excluding labor and travel expenses except in those cases where the end user has paid these expenses for a previous repair. However, labor and travel expenses will only be paid if the failed parts were installed by an authorized Cummins Power Products/Generation Distributor or designated service representative. Non-CPP parts or accessories items are not covered under this warranty.

### **Cummins Power Products Responsibilities**

Cummins Power Products' liability and owner's sole remedy are limited to the repair or replacement, at Cummins Power Products option, of the Product or parts that do not conform to this warranty. In accordance with CPP Warranty Administration policies, CPP will pay for the parts and labor required to repair the Product and, when necessary, reasonable labor expenses associated with the removal and reinstallation of the Product if such work is done by an authorized Cummins Power Products/Generation/Onan Distributor or designated service representative.

In accordance with Cummins Power Products Warranty Administration policies, CPP will pay limited travel expenses for DC generator sets, maximum of 300 miles, and 4 hours travel time when necessary to make on-site repairs. The cost of maintenance items such as oil, filter elements, spark plugs, belts, fuses, hoses, starting batteries, and light bulbs will be paid for by CPP when such items are not reusable because of the warrantable failure.

### **Owner's Responsibilities**

The owner is obligated to install, operate, and maintain the Product in accordance with the recommendations published by Cummins Power Products, including, without limitation, operating within power rating designation set out in Power Rating section for DC generator sets, below. The owner is responsible for the costs associated with such maintenance. The owner is responsible for any adjustments which may be required beyond 90 days from the in service date (Break-in period.) (Adjustments allowed are only those related to minor corrections for proper operation only.)

Prior to expiration of the applicable warranty and within 30 days after discovery of the warrantable failure, the owner must notify an authorized Cummins Power Products/Generation/Onan Distributor or designated repair facility of any warrantable failure and have the repair or replacement made by such facility. Installation inspection and initial start-up of DC generator sets must be conducted by an authorized Cummins Power Products/Generation/Onan distributor or designated representative.

The owner is responsible for payment of any of the following expenses that might be incurred as a result of failure under the terms of this warranty:

1. Rental equipment used to replace the Product being repaired, other downtime expenses, and all business costs and losses.
2. Repairs, downtime, additional freight, or consequential damages that are found to be the direct result of neglect, or unattended long term storage prior to installation.
3. Telephone, communications, living and travel expenses incurred by the owner.
4. The premium costs for overtime labor requested by the owner.
5. The cost of airfreight or other extraordinary expenses for shipment of parts over and above premium surface transportation.
6. Any other consequential or incidental amounts.

### **Power Ratings**

Cummins Power Products DC generator sets must be applied within the following rating designations:

#### **Standby Power Rating**

The standby power rating is applicable for supplying emergency power for the duration of normal power interruption. No sustained overload capability is available for this rating. This rating is applicable to installations served by a reliable normal utility source. The standby rating is only applicable for emergency and standby applications where the generator set serves as the back-up to the normal utility source.

Note: Time at standstill is not counted.

#### **Limitations**

Cummins Power Products is not responsible for the repair or replacement of Product required because of normal wear, accident, misuse, improper installation, (installing a generator set designated for stationary use in a mobile application), lack of maintenance, unauthorized modifications, improper storage, negligence, improper or contaminated fuel, or use of parts that do not meet Cummins Power Products specifications.

Generator set warranty will not cover any failures associated with Battle Short Mode applications.

**All DC Generator Products must be registered within the Base Warranty period. If this requirement is not followed, a penalty charge will apply. See your Cummins Power Products/Generation Distributor for details.**

**NORMAL WEAR:**

This warranty will not cover a repair where normal use has exhausted the life of a particular part contained within the Product. All mechanical devices need periodic parts replacement and service to perform well. It should be remembered that the service life of any product is dependant on the care it receives and the condition under which it has to operate.

Coolant heaters, engine block heaters, and battery pad heaters will be covered for a period of one year from date of start-up. This warranty shall not apply to starting batteries.

THERE IS NO OTHER EXPRESS WARRANTY, AND NO PERSON IS AUTHORIZED TO GIVE ANY OTHER WARRANTY OR TO ASSUME ANY OTHER LIABILITIES ON CUMMINS POWER PRODUCTS' BEHALF UNLESS MADE OR ASSUMED IN WRITING BY AN OFFICER OF CUMMINS POWER PRODUCTS.

IMPLIED WARRANTIES, INCLUDING MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE ARE LIMITED TO THE PERIODS OF COVERAGE SET FORTH ABOVE. TO THE EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, ANY AND ALL IMPLIED WARRANTIES ARE EXCLUDED. IN NO EVENT IS CUMMINS POWER PRODUCTS LIABLE FOR INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES.

This warranty gives the owner specific rights. The owner may have other rights which vary depending on local laws. In some areas, local laws do not allow limitations on how long an implied warranty lasts or do not allow the exclusion of incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitations may not apply to you.
